

VOLUNTEER HOUR REQUIREMENTS:

25 hours (per Family) for grades Pre-K through 8th
12½ hours (per Family) with only half-day (Pre-K) students

Volunteers must be at least 13 years of age.

EXAMPLES OF ACTIVITIES THAT COUNT AS VOLUNTEER HOURS

Lunch Parent	1 hour per lunch
Home & School meeting attendance	2 hours per family (not per parent)
Home & School Association Officer or Committee Chair	10 hours plus hours worked
Scout Troop/Den/Pack leaders and Assistants for meetings only. No other scouting event or job.	Hours worked
Donation to classroom parties as requested by the teacher and/or home room mother such as food, party favors, etc.	1 hour per \$12 spent
Cooking times	Must be reasonable amount of time
Donations, as requested, to Home & School Supply Closet	1 hour per \$12 spent

SOME EXAMPLES OF NON-APPROVED HOURS

Attending Orientation, Open House and/or Parent Nights
Attending School Mass or Ambassador Sundays at parishes (unless working a table)
Garage Sale Donations
Silent/Live Auction Donations (cash, merchandise, basket contributions, etc.)
Tickets/Purchases for School Sponsored Fundraisers (Auction, Auction Purchases, Raffle Tickets, etc.)
Purchase of any Home & School Fundraiser Items (including cash to walk-a-thons, read-a thons, etc.)
Boy Scout or Girl Scout camping trips
Paid Services (Services rendered for which YOU received payment)
Purchase of Yearbook Advertisements, Page Sponsorships or Yearbooks
Snacks for sports teams and birthday treats for your child’s classroom(s)
