

Summer Camp Update

Over the last few weeks, our Administration, Summer Camp Director, and School Nurse have been working hard on creating new safety protocols to keep our campus and our campers as safe as possible. In following CDC guidelines, some of the safety guidelines we are implementing include:

- Keeping campers in groups of 10 or less
- Checking temperature of each camper via infrared thermometer each morning (non-invasive)
- Checking oxygen saturation rate of any camper registering a temperature at or above 99.5 degrees (non-invasive)
- A rotating schedule for campers to avoid cross-over with other campers
- Designating small group lunch areas
- Training staff on safety and sanitation procedures
- Adult employees in contact with the campers will wear masks, with the exception of outside time
- Cleaning and sanitation schedule for common areas such as bathrooms and playgrounds

Please be aware that we are working in a very fluid environment. The above guidelines may change as new information is received from the State of Florida, CDC, and the Diocese of Pensacola/Tallahassee.

Please make sure you have done the following:

- Send in all Summer Camp forms (attached). You can e-mail it back to Mrs. Knickerbocker or send with your child on the first Monday your child attends Camp.
- If your child is missing necessary immunizations for school attendance, those immunizations will need to be updated before your child is allowed to attend Camp.
- We will also need every parent to sign the Summer Camp Liability waiver before the start of camp which can be accessed on our Trinity website. (also attached)

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to COVID-19 (Participants)

The novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization.
