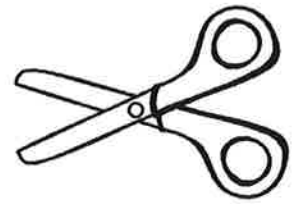

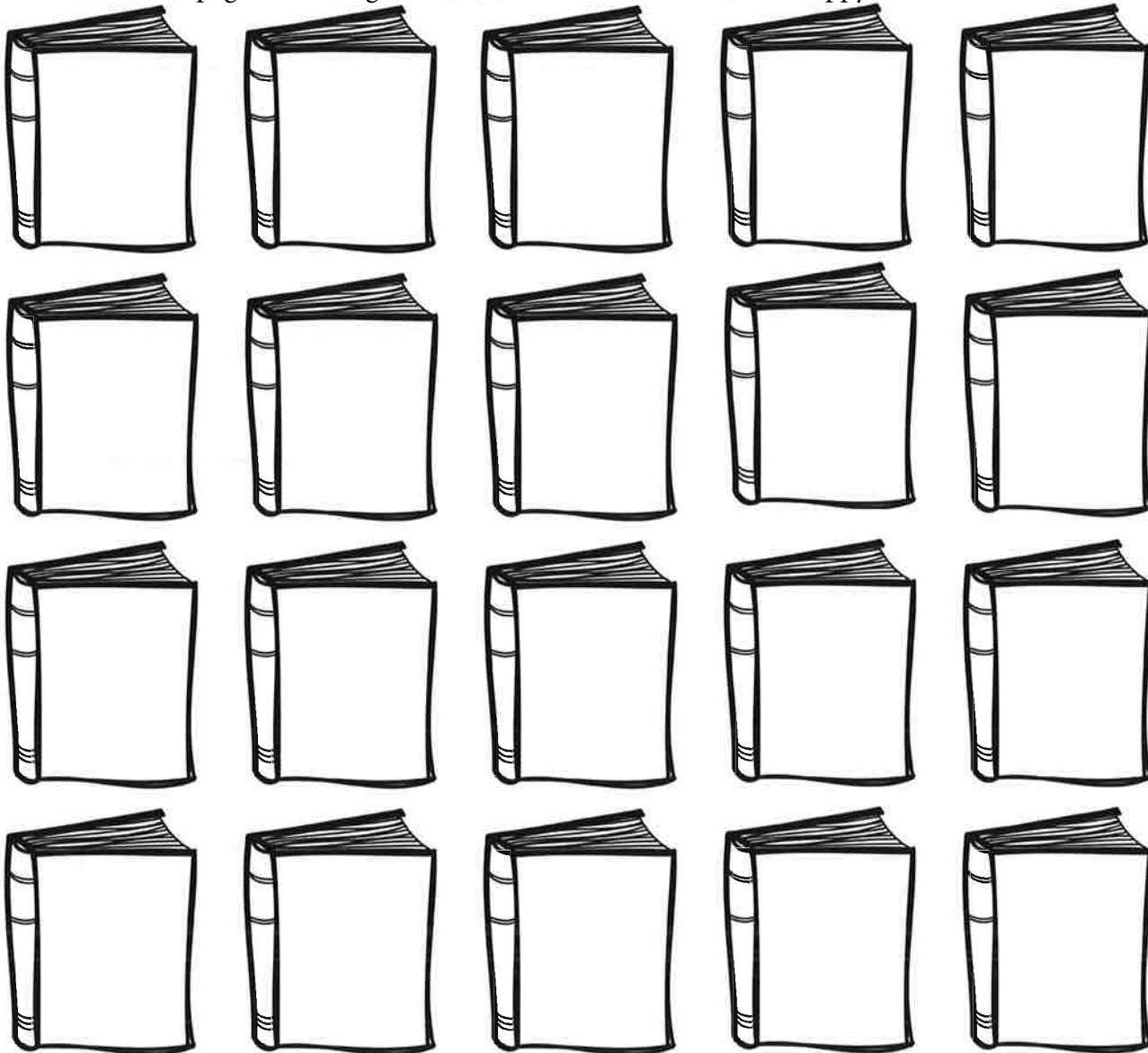

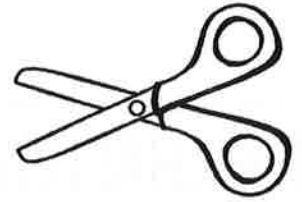


SUMMER READING CHALLENGE
